## Extra credit

## Students wishing to improve their grade may choose only <u>one</u> of the following for extra credit. The extra credit you choose will be only applied to that category of your grade.

## Who May Do the Extra Credit?

- 1. Students who have completed every assignment, lab, and assessment. If you have not completed all of these, you may not do extra credit to replaced the credit lost.
- 2. All students who fulfill the requirements in #1, can participate.
- \*\*<u>Extra credit cannot help you achieve the 98% to not have to take the final exam</u>. Those students wishing to to <u>NOT</u> have to take the final exam, must earn the 98% without the help of extra credit.
- \*\*The maximum end of semester grade that a student can earn with extra credit is a 97.9%- A. You cannot earn an A+ with extra credit.

\*\*Students may do one extra credit assignment per chapter.

- \*\*Any extra credit that requires instructor approval must have approval prior to starting the extra credit.
- \*\*Extra credit is due the day of the test. No exceptions.
- \*\*Extra credit will be in tiers. Percent values are awarded and determined based on the complexity and correctness.
- \*\*The awarding of extra credit percentages is at my discretion and cannot be challenged. After all, it is extra credit.
